What are the goals of the program?

Digital publishing can help people improve their communities by giving them tools to connect people and ideas. Our specific goals are:

- To enable more people to enter the digital conversation by lowering the technical barriers to entry.
- To provide powerful tools for digital publication, free and open to all.
- To encourage people to improve their communities by supporting the free exchange of information and ideas.



What is the Knight Foundation?

Knight Foundation is a Miami-based non-profit organization. Since 1950, the foundation has invested more than \$300 million to advance quality journalism and freedom of expression worldwide.

Who can apply for a grant?

Anyone may register on <http://groups.drupal.org> and submit a proposal.

What kind of proposals are wanted?

Any ideas that help achieve the goals of the program, including those which strengthen the Drupal community.

Must my proposal involve Drupal?

Yes. This is a Drupal-specific program, sponsored by Knight Foundation.

How do I apply?

Go to <http://groups.drupal.org/knight-drupal-initiative> and submit a proposal after reviewing the guidelines.

How are grants reviewed?

A two-stage process starts with an open community review. Selected proposals are then passed to Knight Foundation for final review.
