



#### You need Views if

- You like the default front page view, but you find want to sort it differently.
- You like the default taxonomy/term view, but you fin you want to sort it differently; for example, alphabetically.
- You use /tracker, but you want to restrict it to posts of a tain type.
- You like the idea of the 'article' module, but it doesn't displanticles the way you like.
- You want a way to display a block with the 5 most recent posts
- · You want to provide 'unread forum posts'.
- You want a monthly archive similar to the typical Movable Type/Work ress archives that
  displays a link to the in the form of "Month, YYYY (X)" where X is the number of posts that
  month, and displays them in a block. The links lead to a simple list of posts for that month.

Views can do a lot more than that, but those are some of the obvious uses of Views

#### Views for Drupal 8

Views is in Drupal 8 Core!

#### Recommended versions of Views!

For new installs of Drupal 6, we recommend the 6.x-3.x branch. We have not changed the recommended version you see below, because there is an upgrade bug in 6.x-2.x that causes upgraded views to break. We don't want anyone getting a surprise breakage of their site.

The 6.x-2.x branch of Views is in critical/security maintenance mode only. If we can fix the upgrade issue, that will absolutely be fixed and the branch will officially be deprecated at that

# And it's really useful to learn!

#### **Essential Channels to Join**

- #drupal is a lounge of sorts. Here, we talk about patches we need reviewed, quick how-to
  questions, and what we've been doing with Drupal lately, among other things. If it's Drupalrelated, and isn't in-depth enough to take over the channel with lots of text, and doesn't
  need a quiet venue, it is fair game in #drupal.
- #drupal-contribute is the place to go if you want to help with core and contrib coding work,
  promotion, advocacy, infrastructure, and general Drupal community tasks. The rule of thumb
  here: if it ends up on the drupal.org infrastructure, and you are working on it or want to work
  on it, then this is the place to talk about it.
- #drupal-support is for long or deep support discussions. While quick questions are okay in #drupal, some discussions are just too long for that channel, or need a quieter venue -that's when they go in #drupal-support.
