Install

Content type(s)

Default options

- Published
- Promoted to front page
- Sticky at top of lists
- Create new revision
- New revision in draft, pending moderation (requires "Create new revision")

Users with the *Administer content* permission will be able to override these options.

▼ NEW REVISION IN DRAFT

Create new revision:

- Only when saving *page* content that is not already in draft/pending moderation
- Every time *page* content is updated, even when saving content in draft/pending moderation

Use less disk space and avoid cluttering your revisions list. With the first option ticked, modifications are saved to the same copy (i.e. no additional revisions are created) until the content is published.

- Auto-publish drafts of type *page* (for moderators)

If this box is ticked and the user has one of the "Publish content revisions" permissions, then any draft of type *page* is published immediately upon saving, without further review or the option to schedule a publication date.

Status

Pros

- Author – can now create content that must be approved/denied by the moderator
- Moderator – can now approve/deny content created immediately or via schedule

Cons

- Locating content for moderation.
- There is no communication between the author and moderator.

Locating Content

- Navigate to Structure > Views
- View the Content Summary
(Really, you just have to look at the page to activate the link to display in the admin bar.)
- End Result:
 - A link in the toolbar for the administrator and moderator

Communication: Rules

Author Saves Content

- Event
 - After saving new content
- Condition
 - User has role(s) – author
- Action
 - Send mail to all users of a role: – moderator
 - Message: [node:author] has saved [node:url]. Please view the page and set it to publish.

Moderator Publishes Content

- Event
 - Pending revision has been published
- Condition
 - None
- Action
 - Send mail - To: revision:author:mail
