One of my big contributions were a virtual filesystem utilizing Drupal nodes as folders with attached files as files within the folders. This virtual filesystem can accessed via WebDav and a web interface. The filesystem makes it possible to store files across different servers. It also contains a wrapper where external data and services could be exposed as a file. Files could be uploaded via WebDAV or drag'n'drop on the webpage. Files of 2GB+ is supported.
