

The site admin can make a node type that uses a "node emailer" field type. The node emailer field type can do one or all of the following:

- 1) make a hidden list of email addresses to email any node created that uses the node_emailer field type.
- 2) provide a text field where a user making a new node that has a node_emailer field type on it can enter a single email address to which the node will be emailed.
- 3) send an email to any field types of "email" (provided by <http://cvs.drupal.org/viewcvs/drupal/contributions/modules/email/>) based on nodereferences. So, if a user makes a new node and uses a nodereference for another node type, and the other existing node has an email field, the new node will get emailed to that referenced node's email field(s).
